

OBERON SHOW SOCIETY INC

REGULATIONS

1. The Showgrounds will be open for general admission from 8am and close at the discretion of the committee. All exhibitors to pay admission.
2. Admission fee to the ground for non members: Adults \$10.00 per day, \$5.00 Child and Age Pensioners. Non members leaving the ground must receive pass outs or admission will be re charged. If a re-issue of a ticket is required for any reason, a Statutory Declaration will be required to be made.
3. All entries must be made in writing and delivered to the Secretary's Office. Late entries may be accepted at the Stewards' discretion.
4. All Fat Stock to be bona fi de property of exhibitors for at least 2 months prior to date of show and declaration shall be made to this effect if demanded by stewards.
All other exhibits must be bona fi de property of exhibitors at date of entry. Nothing to indicate ownership of exhibit will be permitted (brands on livestock excepted).
5. Exhibitors of livestock for competition must at time of entry state age, breed, and breeders if required.
6. All persons, after entering exhibits, stock in particular, to give notice of their inability to exhibit 24 hours before the first day of show.
7. If there is no competition in any section the judges may withhold the prize if they deem the exhibit unworthy.
8. Any exhibitor who shall give misleading information respecting any exhibit to any officer of the Association shall forfeit their right to any prizes that may have been awarded to them.
9. No person other than officials will be permitted into the show buildings while judging is in progress.
10. No person other than officials will be allowed in the ring with the judges during competition.
11. No horse other than exhibits shall be allowed to be ridden or driven in the show ring.
12. Exhibits shall be arranged by Stewards or by the exhibitor under the direction of Stewards.
13. Non-competitive exhibits must have the name of the exhibitor on them and be marked "non-competitor" and displayed in designated

areas.

14. The Association, while taking all reasonable care, does not hold itself responsible for exhibits that may be stolen, lost, injured or destroyed, including livestock.

15. Exhibitors to check with Section Steward as to the time that exhibits may be removed.

16. No exhibit of livestock will be allowed to run loose on the ground.

17. Any exhibit (excepting livestock) having once competed at any of the Association's shows, cannot be exhibited again.

18. Commercial exhibitors (when entering) must give notice of space they require.

19. Protests shall be lodged within one hour of an award in all sections.

20. Protests must be delivered to the Secretary in writing, accompanied by a fee of \$5.00 which may be forfeited if the protest is considered frivolous.

21. All persons exhibiting shall accept the decision of the judge's appointed by the committee of the Association and in cases of disputes and protests the decision of the committee shall be final and without appeal.

22. No exhibit shall be allowed to compete in more than one class except where specified.

23. Any exhibitor or any other person giving offence to or interfering with officials, judges, or stewards while in the execution of their duties, or removing any official placard or ticket from exhibits may be removed from the ground and disqualified at the committee's pleasure.

24. All dogs in all sections must be suitably restrained between events or will be impounded.

25. The attention of exhibitors is especially drawn to the foregoing regulations, for any disregard of same shall render the exhibitor to be disqualified.

26. The Council reserves the right to at any time postpone or abandon the exhibition in consequence of the weather or any other sufficient cause. No entrance fee shall be refunded, if postponed all entries shall be refunded in the case of abandonment or cancellation. No obligation shall be maintained or be incurred by the reason of such postponement or abandonment.

27. Passes will be issued to commercial exhibitors at the discretion of the committee.

28. All competitors or exhibitors must pay at the gate unless they are a member of the Society.

29. All prizes awarded at the show shall be payable at the show, except where protests are entered.

30. All prizes not applied for by the closing of the second day of the show can be picked up on Monday 11am -1pm, or shall be forfeited to the association.

31. No alcohol to be brought into the Showground.
